Water-Logged Wheat Crop and *CropKarb*

In areas of the country that have been inundated with excessive rainfall, it is imperative that we focus on root activity and grain-fill, two areas of crop health that are affected by these wet soils. It is not too late to have a positive impact on final wheat yield.

At *DeltAg*, we have had great response to the application of *CropKarb* in the early stages of joint-movement and Boot-Flag Leaf. Most growers simply make these foliar applications along with an insecticide, herbicide or in most cases their fungicide applications.

For efficient completion of the heading process, the crop needs an active root system, ample potassium for grain-fill and healthy translocation within the plant. The *CropKarb* formula contains *PercPlus*, *Potassium Plus* to supplement potassium levels and *Boron Plus*.

CropKarb at 32 ounces per acre at this stage of crop development has consistently been shown to be beneficial.

Tissue Testing: With these persistent heavy rains, there have been reported observations of chlorosis in many wheat fields that have been identified as micronutrient issues. Also, in some areas wheat tissue samples have been pulled and some of these samples are calling for different micronutrients. *MicroVite*, at 32 ounces per acre, is a proven micronutrient combo product from *DeltAg* that will provide ample zinc, magnesium, manganese, copper and sulfur.
