Dealing with Mother Nature and Corn

With planting season upon us, we finally caught a break and were able to get some corn in the ground, particularly in the south. Having the use of larger equipment has allowed us to cover a significant number of acres in a single day, making up for any time that was thought lost due to a late start. However, about the time we think we're getting back on track, what happens? Mother Nature takes a turn for the worse and sends us more rain, hail and cold weather. This leaves us wondering about the condition of these planted crops.

Many growers have found that **PercPlus** @ 16 to 24 oz per acre has been very beneficial during stress due to adverse weather conditions. If there is additional stress in the form of chlorosis due to zinc or magnesium concerns, adding **MicroVite** @ 32 oz per acre in with the **PercPlus** will help the crop to get back on track much quicker.

If you have not planted, consider **DeltAg Seed Coat** (a dry hopper box treatment). We also use **PercPlus** @ 8 oz per acre with in-furrow starter fertilizer programs to help young seedling crops to the next stage of normal development.
