How Do I Apply Seed Coat? As a dry seed treatment, simply replace your talc and apply *Seed Coat* to the bulk bag of seed or the seed hopper at a rate of one to two ounces per acre and lightly stir it into the seed before planting. 12.5 Lb Pail - Treats 3,000 to 5,000 Lbs of Seed (4 ounce scoop included)

Common Questions About Seed Coat:

What type seed? Any type Seed! Soybean... Cotton... Corn... Rice... Grass... Vegetables

Can I apply too much to the seed? No! Only so much will adhere to the seed. Follow Label Directions.

How long will Seed Coat stay good if not used? Indefinitely! Keep the container closed and the *Seed Coat* dry!
